David Jones, originally from South East London, now lives with his wife Louise in Leonia NJ, gateway to the golden west. Tom Goslin, an outstanding guitarist, now lives with his wife Sandra just north of Manhattan, and a stone's throw from the Hudson River. He has played for Musical Theater from Broadway to all points east and west throughout the known world and is in great demand as an accompanist and as a solo performer. Tom also plays banjo, mandolin and lute and his renditions of impossible classical pieces on the plastic slide whistle, as well as his performances of songs of dalliance and merriment, have been greeted with enormous applause from coast to coast.
